**School Craft Sessions got** underway in the 3rd week back at school. All the children made fabulous Christmas card designs and for those who ordered them, we hope you have enjoyed your child's artwork. This initiative raised around £150 for our school this year and was a great deal of fun to boot.



Autumn Cake Sale took place on the final day of the first term and was ably hosted by Oak class. The spread of treats available was simply amazing and everyone was able to go away with a great deal of cake! Oak raised a terrific £232 from the sale which is a wonderful amount when you consider the size of our school. Thank you so much to all the children who played a part in the baking and the selling of this wonderful spread of delicious-ness!



**Walk Tonbridge Marathon** took place on 22nd September and five parents took part, raising money for four charities, including our school PTA. The team raised almost £3,900 in total, meaning over £900 for our school. Despite iffy weather conditions, they had a lot of fun and the incredible support made every blister worth it!



Bonfire Night at the start of half term was a great success. The weather was ultimately kind and we drew a capacity crowd from far beyond our village. Feedback has been really positive with the smaller feel of the event coupled with sensational fireworks and a bonfire the size of the Eiffel Tower (almost!) making for a fabulous night out. Thank you to the team who makes this happen and Penshurst Fuels for their incredibly generous sponsorship of the event.



Bag2School was, this year, disappointing as the collection company dropped their rate from 50p to 20p/kg - in the week prior to collection. The price pressure is due to a number of geopolitical reasons. We therefore only received £58 for what is a laborious task. We are unlikely to take part in 2025 unless the rate rises again.



School Christmas! took place on 13th December with Secret Present Room, festive own clothes day and the Christmas party. Every aspect was joyful. Thanks to Madds for selling wreaths on behalf of the PTA, raising a marvellous £267. Thank you also Penshurst Place for the generous donation of a beautiful tree that has graced the hall through December, and lovely books for all the children. SPR raised just shy of £1,000 for our school which is amazing.


### Friends of Penshurst **Coffee Morning**
