Tasks – Set 1

Art/DT

Create an information collage around the question “Who were the Romans?” Use text, images, online information, and drawings to present your thoughts. Explain how and why the Romans came to Britain and what they accomplished.



History

Research a famous Roman Emperor. What did they achieve? Why are they famous?



English

Read some articles about climate change, environmental issues and wildlife endangerment (National Geographic and National Geographic Kids are examples). Note down interesting facts and create an information poster about the issues – make it as artistic as you like.

Tasks – Set 2

Art/DT

Create a pair of Roman sandals. Research how they were made, design your sandals, identify the materials you will need, the skills you are going to use and then make your sandals.

Upload a picture of you wearing them!



History

Investigate and write about the impact the Romans had (and still have) on Britain.

English

Create your own newspaper report about something that is happening in the world that interests you. Use features of newspaper articles (images, headlines, technical vocabulary, etc.).



Tasks – Set 3

Science

Produce a double page spread detailing all you know about plants – how they live, grow, what they need to survive, etc. Use at least one “pop up” device in your work.



R.E.

Give examples about how Christians prepare for Christmas during the season of Advent. Make links between some of the texts and teachings about God in the Bible, and what people believe about God today.

English

Present information about the Roman struggles in Britain against the Celts. Create an information article, book or fact file.
