P.E.

Children will be focusing on running skills, in particular Cross-Country running. Prominent skills are pacing and distance work.

SCIENCE

MATHS

Children will focus on additive and multiplicative reasoning this term. There will be a focus on developing times tables skills and mental arithmetic, as well as written techniques.

COMPUTING: The children will learn to apply logical thinking and develop their coding skills

ENGLISH

Children will study newspaper articles this term. They will focus on using a wide range of grammatical devices and authorial techniques as well as accuracy of spelling and handwriting. Children will complete their study by writing an independent article using the skills learned.

READING

Children will study a range of books and learn to analyse them. They will express their understanding verbally and in writing, answering comprehension questions and inferring ideas.

SPELLING

Children will refine their understanding of spelling patterns appropriate to their year group, ensuring sound understanding of each word.

History

Children will study the Romans this term, specifically Roman Emperors who came to Britain and the impact the Romans had on Britain during their occupation.
