

Maths

In maths we will be working on counting accurately, recognising and ordering numbers. We will explore ways of making numbers to 10 and then 20. We will also be looking at doubling and halving and positional language.

Physical Development

Our PE programme will start with BEAM, a programme that focuses on developing balance, agility and co-ordination. This will move onto gymnastics where these skills are developed further.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be talking about classroom rules, rights, responsibilities and needs. We will be finding out about our school values and the importance of everybody being recognised as individuals, unique and special.

Expressive Art and Design

As part of our art and design sessions we will be working towards creating a storytelling box. We will be studying the famous artists Kurt Schwitters & Eric Carl and we will be developing the techniques of collage. We will also use a range of materials and techniques to create characters for our stories.

During our RE sessions we will be talking and finding out about what Christians believe God is like.
