

Reading

Our class text for this term will be Roald Dahl's George's Marvellous Medicine. While some children may already be familiar with this book, we will delve deeper and examine just how Dahl has been so successful here as a storyteller. We will use Destination Reader to build on the skills of predicting, inferring, summarising, asking questions, clarifying and making links.

Writing

Much of our writing this term will be linked to our text, George's Marvellous Medicine. We will look at how Roald Dahl puts together character descriptions before writing our own, and we will write instructions for our own medicines.

Maths

Children will work on times tables, practising them orally to support them in the times tables test later in the year.

In maths this term, children will learning about and reasoning within place value on ordering and comparing numbers; written and mental methods for addition and subtraction and multiplying mentally.





Art and DT

Our main focus for this term will be DT, where children will design and construct potion or perfume bottles using clay. After researching and designing their bottles to suit a particular purpose, children will develop their skills of coiling to construct their bottles. In art, we will take inspiration from Andy Warhol and look at printing in different colours to create label designs for our bottles.

RE

In RE this term we will be exploring the creation and all of the amazing things that can be found in our environment

Science

This term in science, we will be exploring states of matter - solids, liquids and gases. We will explore what it means for a substance to be solid, liquid or gas and how they change as they transition between states.

PE

In PE this term, we will play tag rugby learning passing and teamwork skills and building on strategies for attacking and defending.

History

In history we will explore the history of medicine, learning which treatments might have been offered at different times.
