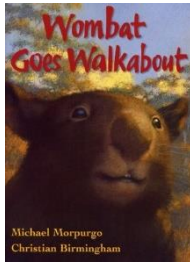


# Remote learning- Year 1-2

## Tasks – Set 1

### English:

Research facts about Wombats- their habitats, what they need in order to survive. Record your findings on a piece of paper and include a drawing of a Wombat.



### History:

Create a fact file on Queen Elizabeth II either on a word document or on paper. Include information such as her date of birth, how long she has been Queen and her family.

Go onto Phonics Play and practise Phase 4 and 5 phonics. Play any of the games available. <https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/>



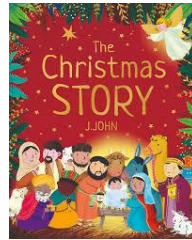
## Tasks – Set 2

### English:

### Science:

Investigate: go out into an outside area and look for mini beasts/ insects and write or draw them onto a piece of paper. Can you name them? What do you know about the animals? Are there any similarities or differences between the ones you have found?

### English:

### Art:

Create a family tree for Queen Elizabeth II. Draw/paint/make the relevant photos to put on each part of the tree.
