Computing: We will be using Purple Mash and completing the units: grouping and sorting, pictograms and lego builders. P.E.: Children will develop their fitness and agility through a variety of games and activities. MATHS: We will begin the term looking at measurements including length. We will then move onto Geometry, focusing on 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.



Elm Class – Curriculum Map – Term 3

Geography: Children will be exploring the use of map skills, looking at different areas of the world, specifically the United Kingdom. **ENGLISH:** During our English sessions, we will be looking at 'Pinocchio' and exploring the narrative.

READING: Within class, we have a class reader that we share daily. Within our reading sessions we will be unpicking poems this term and focusing on understanding key vocabulary.

SPELLING: Children will receive weekly spellings relating to a specific spelling rule discussed within lesson or relating to appropriate phonics knowledge being learnt.

History: We will be learning about Queen Victoria and her impact on the country as well as exploring her beliefs, traditions and key events that occurred during her reign.

R.E: Children will be learning about the good news that Jesus brings. Within this, they will be telling Bible stories and looking at Christian beliefs.

SCIENCE: Children will be studying living things and their habitats. During this topic, we will be exploring the difference between 'living', 'dead' and 'never been alive' as well as different food chains and how specific habitats are suited to different animals.
