Homework Terms 1 and 2, 2020

During the current pandemic we are, in line with government guidelines, reducing the number of items we send from school to home. This is in an effort to reduce the spread of Covid 19. For the coming academic year all homework will be set online and will involve some online activities.

I am sure you will understand that this year, more than any other, we need parents to support the work we are doing in school. Please support our work in school by ensuring your child completes their homework.

Each class has a page on our website and within that page you will find a letter from your child's teacher detailing the homework that has been set. This will include MyMaths, reading online books with Bug Club and for children in Key Stage 2 there will be Times Table Rock Stars activities as well as Spag.com. Each child has an online folder – this is the same folder that was used for home learning during lockdown - within this folder will be your child's weekly spellings.

All children are expected to read each night as this practise is vital to their development – whatever their age or stage as a reader.

We expect that all children complete the homework set by the teacher. Teachers will provide feedback online and many of the programmes we use enable your child to have more than one attempt at the activities.

I cannot emphasise to you enough the important role you play in supporting your child to make progress – practising key skills at home will mean that children have many opportunities to build on their learning.
