'You are always fair and football mad!' 'You are the best speller in the whole school', 'You always have answers to my questions'

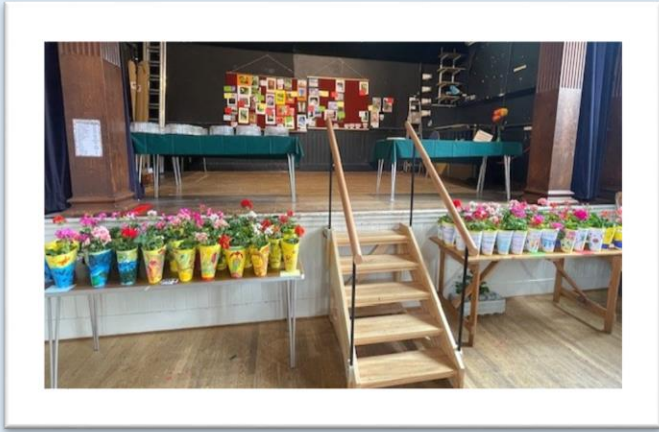
