Children will develop their ball skills through refining specific techniques and applying them in a range of ball games.

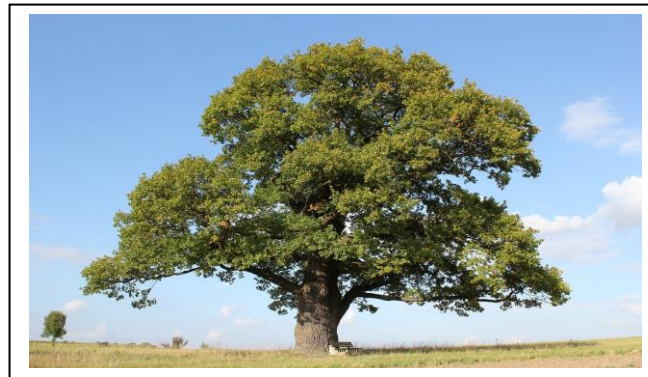
SCIENCE

Children will study the topic of "Light". They will be investigating how light travels in straight lines and using that knowledge to consider why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them. Children will consider how light travels to our eyes and the impact of this..

MATHS

Children will focus on mastering place value, multiplication and division methods and fractions.

They will also develop the key skill of reasoning with numbers and expressing this reasoning verbally and in writing.



Oak Class – Curriculum Map – Term 1

COMPUTING: The children will learn to apply logical thinking and develop their coding skills

ENGLISH

Children will study the film "Paperman" and use this to develop their writing skills. They will focus on using a wide range of grammatical devices and authorial techniques as well as accuracy of spelling and handwriting. Children will complete their study by writing an independent narrative using the skills learned. Towards the end of the term children will analyse the features of a newspaper report using the story of "Goldilocks" as an inspiration. Having mastered these features, children will write an independent newspaper report on a subject of their choice.

READING

Children will study a range of books and learn to analyse them. They will express their understanding verbally and in writing.

SPELLING

Children will refine their understanding of spelling patterns appropriate to their year group, ensuring sound understanding of each word.

ART

Children will study Pop Art using the artist Andy Warhol as a model. As well as studying the style, features and significance of Warhol's work, children will produce an independent piece of art in the same style.
