Reading Books / Reading Records

Homework

Every Tuesday I will be setting the three online weekly homework tasks. These will be

- 'My Maths',
- Spellings which will be uploaded onto the child's individual folder
- An online book set on 'Bug Club' children read the book and complete the linked activities.

These homework tasks will be set every Tuesday and the children will be given until the following Tuesday to complete them. Please support your child to complete these tasks; they are important to their development.

PE will take place on a Monday afternoons. Please could you ensure that your child comes into school in their PE kit; school tracksuit bottoms or other dark coloured jogging bottoms can be worn if the weather is cooler
