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Our key objective in using the Pupil Premium Grant was to narrow the gap between pupil groups. A significant amount of additional funding has been allocated to the school and we are determined to ensure that it has maximum impact. Careful analysis of internal and external pupil-level data, historical attainment and progress rates, and huge amount of qualitative data was undertaken to ensure that these funds are used to maximum effect.

The basis for all the decisions taken have been that this additional money has impact on standards and reduced the gaps between pupil groups. Support for children in all areas of school life has been fundamental and the money has been used for human as well as physical resources.

We have sought external organisations and identified opportunities for children to have an enriched and enhanced experience of the curriculum. Investing small group and 1 to 1 tuition, support with extra-curricular activities, purchasing of additional ICT equipment that can be used by certain pupils at home and purchasing clothing and equipment for inside and outside the classroom are just a few of the curriculum enrichment areas we focused on this year.
