



### **SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS (Updated May 2022)**

<b>Winter Uniform (Terms 2,3 and 4)</b>	<b>Summer Uniform (Terms 1, 5,6)</b>
Grey trousers /grey shorts Grey skirt/pinafore dress Plain white button-up shirt (Yr. R – Yr. 6) OR White polo shirt (Yr. R only) School Tie Royal blue jumper / cardigan Grey socks/White socks/grey tights  <b>NB: Ties are not compulsory in Reception.</b>	Grey trousers/grey shorts Blue checked summer dress/shorts-dress Plain white button up shirt and tie OR blue polo shirt with/without logo (Yr. R – Yr. 6) Royal blue jumper or cardigan. Grey / white socks  Children may wear a school or royal blue baseball cap/ legionnaire's cap
<b>Footwear</b>	
All children should wear black school shoes. Trainers / sandals or boots are not permitted.	
<b>PE Kit</b>	
Black / blue shorts School logo PE t shirt White or black trainers (please avoid fashion trainers or PE shoes with insufficient support for sports use) Grey / white socks (tights should not be worn in PE lessons). In colder months pupils may wear a royal blue tracksuit (or a school logo tracksuit). Fashion leggings are not permitted.  Swimming costume (preferably royal / navy blue) – no Bermuda type shorts or bikinis. A blue fabric or silicone swimming hat (the school can supply a swimming hat with a logo)  Children can come to school dressed in their PE kit.	
<b>Optional Items</b>	
We have a limited number of winter hats, summer coats, school bags and PE/swimming bags available to order. Pupils can wear home versions if preferred.	
<b>Accessories</b>	
Jewellery <b>may not</b> be worn, with the exception of <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a wristwatch or fitness tracker.</li> <li>• one pair of plain studs for pupils with pierced ears.</li> </ul> Pupils with earrings must be able to remove and replace these themselves for PE lessons, and for this reason, we ask that, if you wish you child to have their ears pierced, you do so at the beginning of the summer holidays to give the ears time to heal before returning to school. Staff are not able to remove or replace earrings, and we do not tape ears for PE.  Children should not wear nail varnish or transfer tattoos, please.	
<b>Hair &amp; Hair Styles</b>	
Long hair (below shoulder length) should be tied up away from the face, i.e. ponytail, plait etc. during the school day; this is to comply with health and safety guidance. Hair accessories (i.e. Alice bands, clips, scrunchies or beads) should be <b>blue, yellow</b> or white. Hair should be own natural colour only, no extreme or unkempt hairstyles or shaved patterns are allowed.
