SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

Winter Uniform (to be worn during Terms 2, 3 and 4)

Children have the following winter uniform options:

- Grey trousers/shorts with a plain white button-up shirt, school tie and school jumper or cardigan. Grey socks.
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress with a plain white button-up shirt, school tie and school jumper or cardigan. White or grey socks, or grey tights.

NB: Ties are not compulsory in Reception.

Summer Uniform (to be worn during Terms 1, 5 and 6)

Children have the following summer uniform options:

- Grey trousers or shorts with a light blue polo shirt and school jumper or cardigan. Grey socks.
- Blue checked school dress or shorts-dress with a school jumper or cardigan. White socks.

Children should wear a school baseball cap or legionnaire's cap for playtime and school trips.

Shoes

All children should wear black school shoes. Trainers, sandals or boots are not permitted.

Sports and PE Kit

All children need to keep a full PE kit in school in a drawstring bag. This should contain black or blue shorts, a school PE T-shirt and black/white trainers (during the colder months, children may also keep a school tracksuit in school for PE).

Swimming

All children must wear a school swimming hat during lessons; appropriate swimwear should be worn.

Optional items

Winter hats, winter and summer coats, school bags and PE/swimming bags are also available to order. These items are optional and children may bring their own home versions if preferred.

Accessories

Jewellery may not be worn, with the exception of

- a wristwatch or fitness tracker.
- one pair of plain studs for pupils with pierced ears.

Pupils with earrings must be able to remove and replace these themselves for PE lessons, and for this reason, we ask that, if you wish you child to have their ears pierced, you do so at the beginning of the summer holidays to give the ears time to heal before returning to school. Staff are not able to remove or replace earrings, and we do not tape ears for PE.

Hair & Hair Styles

Long hair (below shoulder length) should be tied up away from the face, i.e. pony tail, plait etc during the school day; this is to comply with health and safety guidance. Hair accessories (i.e. Alice bands, clips, scrunchies or beads) should be blue, yellow or white. Hair should be own natural colour only, no extreme or unkempt hairstyles or shaved patterns are allowed.

Children should not wear nail varnish or transfer tattoos, please.
