

Year 4 – Remote Learning Tasks – Week 7

Science	Materials. This week's task is to investigate materials that would be good for sound proofing – materials that sound can't travel through very easily. See the additional sheet in your folder for more details.
Maths	<p>Complete your tasks on MyMaths. This week, tasks are based around multiplication, division and fractions – including finding fractions of amounts.</p> <p>To continue your learning about time, look for opportunities to include it in your daily life. For example, if you're cooking and the recipe says to simmer for 5 minutes, convert this to seconds. If you watch a film and it lasts for 112 minutes, convert this to hours and minutes; or If you start watching the film at 3 pm, calculate what time it will finish. Keep a record of the time conversions you have made.</p>
Spelling	<p>Some more prefixes:</p> <p>il-: illegal, illegible ir-: irregular, irrelevant, irresponsible re-: redo, refresh, return, reappear, redecorate auto-: autograph, autobiography</p> <p>You can practise these words using any of the techniques we use at school – pyramid letters, coloured writing, separating syllables and as handwriting practice. When you complete your next piece of writing can you highlight where you have used some of these words?</p>
Reading	<p>Have a go at the comprehension that's in your folder. It is based on the lyrics to "Kick, Push" by Lupe Fiasco.</p> <p>Choose a paragraph from a book you are reading and write some comprehension questions for a member of your family to answer. Try to include some retrieval questions (when the person answering the questions has to find facts) and inference questions (involving the opinion of the person answering the questions).</p>
Writing	<p>Write a "Super Sentence Stacking" story with Jane Considine and the nation following our school "Write Stuff" programme. 9:45am every day.</p> <p>One of your spelling words is "autobiography" – a biography of the writer. Your additional writing task for this week is to write an autobiography of your life so far. Which important events will you write about? You could use your final paragraph to mention some of the things you hope to do in the future.</p>
Art / DT	<p>Graffiti is a significant part of hip hop culture. Whilst some graffiti is used to show support for a gang or to mark territory, there is a growing culture of "street art" that is considered to be more art than vandalism.</p> <p>Your task this week is to create some art inspired by street art. You could look at some notable artists. See the additional information sheet in your folder for some ideas.</p>
